RULES and PROCEDURES TO REMEMBER

- *ALL dogs must be on a leash
- *Please use the provided garbage receptacles to keep the park clean
- *Please NO generators after 10pm
- *Please contact your club rep for all concerns/complaints
- **Please DO NOT bother the score keepers on race days; Saturday and/or Sunday Protests may only be lodged by riders in the same Moto and must be lodged with the rider's chapter representative in writing, within 60 minutes after results are posted of the Moto in question.**
- *If a rider leaves the track, they must safely re-enter as close to the point of exit without improving their position.
- *Changing motorcycles during a Moto will be cause for disqualification.
- *Scorekeepers **MUST** be notified of bike number changes.
- *When a yellow or Red Cross flags are displayed, there is no passing or jumping between the flag and the incident that caused the yellow flag.
- *Decisions made by the presiding Riding Committee are final.

Abusive language or aggressive conduct toward race officials, scorers, volunteers, or other racers will not be tolerated. Racers engaging in this type of behavior are subject to ejection from the event, their entry fees will not be refunded, and they will forfeit their points.

Number Plates must have Proper Backgrounds

Master	Black with White numbers
Expert	White with Black numbers
Intermediate	Yellow with Black numbers
Novice	Green with White numbers

Riders who do not have proper backgrounds will be docked a lap for each Moto they ride with the wrong colors.
