Any changes to the race order will be posted on Facebook, the tower window and announced. Protests may only be lodged by riders in the same moto and must be lodged with the rider's chapter representative in writing, within 60 minutes of the results posted of the moto in question.

RULES and PROCEDURES TO REMEMBER

- *ALL dogs must be on a leash
- *Please use the garbage receptacles provided to keep the park clean
- *Please NO generators after 9pm
- *Please contact your club rep for all concerns/complaints
- **Please DO NOT bother the score keepers on race days. Race protests may only be lodged by riders in the same moto and must be lodged with the rider's chapter representative in writing, within 60 minutes of the moto in question being posted.**
- *If a rider leaves the track, they must safely re-enter as close to the point of exit without improving their position.
- *Changing motorcycles during a Moto will be cause for disqualification.
- *Scorekeepers **MUST** be notified of bike number changes.
- *When a yellow or Red Cross flag is displayed, there is no passing or jumping between the flag and the incident that caused the flag.
- *Decisions made by the presiding Riding Committee are final.

Abusive language or aggressive conduct toward race officials, scorers, volunteers, or other racers will not be tolerated. Racers engaging in this type of behavior are subject to ejection from the event, their entry fees will not be refunded, and they will forfeit their points.

Number Plates must have Proper Backgrounds

Master	Black with White numbers
Expert	White with Black numbers
Intermediate	Yellow with Black numbers
Novice	Green with White numbers

70 experts may run black or white backgrounds.

Riders who do not have proper backgrounds will be docked a lap for each Moto they ride with the wrong colors. Colored tape will be available
